



## Why Am I Here

- Improve cardiac arrest outcome
- Over 36,000 out of hospital cardiac arrests per year in England
- Less than 1 in 10 survive to be discharged from hospital



Current Survival ratesNationallycurrently 8%South Westcurrently 6%

Denmark 22% Holland 65% of cardiac arrests have a defibrillator on prior to ambulance arrival.

Establish CPR training in all schools and mobilise relevant organisations to ensure this is done.

Identify simple consistent messages for the public, and achieve greater public awareness of what to do when faced with an out-of-hospital cardiac arrest

Improve audit and set up a national defibrillator database.

Danger – to me; anyone else; the casualty

**Response – Shout for help** 

Airway – Open and clear of the tongue

Breathing – Not breathing normally, get help/dial 999

**Circulation – Start CPR**
