



Smart Energy GB In Communities: Smart meter roll out 2018

DCT is running a 6 month project this year, funded by Smart Energy GB and we are looking for up to 20 volunteers from the DSV network to help us with delivering this project. We are looking for volunteers who, with training and support from DCT project staff, will help us to reach our target groups of people aged 65+ and people aged 60+ with no personal internet access and provide information about the smart meter roll out and the benefits of having a smart meter installed (research indicates that 20% of households in our target group do not have internet access).

We will be seeking to reach older people with no internet access and so will focus our community- based activities at older people and their carers in rural communities.

We are planning to deliver a rural roadshow of local Smart Energy events, aimed at raising awareness of the benefits of smart meters and provision of information about installation and usage. Local events may include:

- events which are intended to tell people about smart meters, or smart meter workshops/ sessions that you run at another event
- public meetings, fairs, shows, coffee mornings or setting up an information stand
