








How we are funded



In Quarter 3, we advised:

8,312 clients with **28,093** issues

And maximised their income by £5,102.456

Quarter by quarter, we are seeing an increase in demand for assistance by approximately:

- Energy 90%
- Debt 40%
- Housing 20%
- Welfare benefits 5%

The public value of improving clients' wellbeing (emotional, family and relationships and positive functioning)

We are working in partnership with the NHS in the Eastern LCP to source and administer fuel vouchers to patients on discharge from the RDU, particularly those that have respiratory issues.




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


Top Issues Q3 - 2024/25
