

## **Introducing Doink**

Rising rates of sexually transmitted infections in young people living in the southwest is proof that the message of wearing a condom to protect yourself and your partner is more important than ever. Last year, there was a 32% increase in new STI diagnoses among those under the age of 25 in Devon. It is hoped that the new service will play a crucial role in tackling this trend, helping to reduce onward transmission of STIs.

For that reason lets us introduce you to Doink. the new way for young people aged 13-24 in Devon and Torbay to get free condoms, dams and lube.





## **Plymouth**



The C@SHiP scheme is a confidential service which entitles anyone aged 13–24 living in Plymouth & Cornwall quick and easy access to **FREE** regular/latex free condoms every 12 weeks.






## Devon & Torbay – Doink (online service)

## Eligibility – Online registrations

#### Ages 12 & Under

- Not eligible to access the service
- Please signpost to local NHS services
- Please also report by following your organisations safeguarding procedures

#### **Ages 13-15**

- Eligible to register and access the service
- Mandatory completion of Fraser competency check, upon first access and every 3 months
- Checks completed via callback or by attending a local distribution point

#### **Ages 16-24**

- Eligible to register and access the service
- Users must complete safeguarding questions (less questions post 18)
- Any safeguarding triggers checks will be completed via callback or by attending a local distribution point





Once a young person has signed up online, they will be able to show professionals at collection sites their online profile (if they choose not to have condoms delivered).





## Young people can also sign up at a face-to-face registration point.


