- Funded by DCC, administered by Devon Communities Together.
- Available to groups with an emergency plan or flood plan in place, or those who
 are developing a plan and can clearly show how funding will support activity

- Up to £1500 available to fund equipment and minor practical works that will reduce risk and provide immediate benefit to the community.

Property Level Resilience Grant

- Funded by Devon County Council and supported by DEFRA
- For homeowners who have been affected by internal flooding or who are at very high risk of flooding.
- Up to £5,000 to help fund the provision of resistance measures that will help reduce the risk of flooding to individual properties. The grant will be paid retrospectively to the homeowner's chosen contractor, on completion of works.
- A survey will be required prior to agreement of works, which will be conducted by DCC's appointed surveyor and funded by DCC from the individual's grant allocation.
- Funding will be allocated subject to the number and priority of applications received and there can be no guarantee of funding being provided, even if the required criteria is met.
